In order to enjoy the full Festival Winds experiences, successfull applicants are required to attend all the scheduled rehearsals and activities.

Participants will be responsible for their own transportation to and fro from the rehearsal/performance venue.

Open Call for Student Soloist

To provide more opportunities for soloistic playing, we are having an open call for student soloists this year! Stand a chance to perform a solo, accompanied by a wind band, in the prestigious Esplanade Concert Hall!

The open call is only applicable for students playing on a woodwind, or brass, or percussion instrument. Participant must successfully register as a Festival Winds participant before submitting recording. The audition repertoire is limited to only existing works written for solo instrument with wind band. All interested parties are required to submit a video link of their playing. The student's full body must be shown in the video when performing the proposed repertoire.

Participants who do not fulfil the requirements stated above will forfeit their entry. Deadline for the open call will be 12th November 2022, 11:59pm. The judges' decision is final.
